

eurobrass Covid-19 Protocol
updated June 2025

In comparison to the uproar of 2020–21, Covid-19 has largely faded out of the public consciousness on both sides of the Atlantic. We'd love to forget about it, too. But because of the interdependent nature of our work (in which every individual has their own part to play—quite literally), the communicability of Covid-19, and the potential for long-term health effects, we feel it's wise to have some precautions in place in the event that one of us falls ill during the tour. Obviously, we're hoping and praying that everybody remains healthy for the duration of our time together, and that we won't need these guidelines at all. But in case we do, we wanted to give you a heads-up in advance. Here's the plan:

If anyone begins exhibiting cold/flu systems, that person needs to test daily for Covid until symptoms improve. We'll provide tests.

In the event of a positive test:

- No further testing will be necessary—all decisions after a positive test will be made based on progress of the individual's symptoms.
- We'll book a hotel room for the individual.
- No one who tests positive will perform again until symptoms begin to improve.
- The infected team member and leadership will decide together if that person is able to travel to the next location with the team (and how to accomplish that without putting anyone else at unnecessary risk).
- Anyone who tests positive will be asked to wear a mask anytime they're around the team until symptoms improve. We'll provide masks. Masks will also be available for other team members if they wish.
